Entry Requirements

- **A-Level or its equivalent**
Minimum Grade D in two (2) of the following subjects:
 - a. Biology
 - b. Physics/Mathematics
 - c. Chemistry
- **Recognised Diploma in related field**
Minimum CGPA of 2.75, or a CGPA below 2.75 combined with at least 3 years (36 months) of relevant work experience in the related field.

English Competency Requirements (International Student)

- Achieve a minimum of Band 4 in MUET; OR equivalent to CEFR (Mid B2); OR
- IELTS: 6.0; OR
- TOEFL iBT: 60; OR
- Pearson English Test (PTE): 59; OR
