Entry Requirements

• Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) or equivalent qualifications

Pass in Bahasa Malaysia and English with three (3) credits in the following subjects:

- Mathematics or ONE science subject (Biology/ Physics/Chemistry/General Science); and
- Any other TWO subjects (including Bahasa Malaysia and/or English)

• GCE/O-Level/IGCSE or equivalent qualifications

Pass in Bahasa Malaysia and English with three (3) credits (Grade C) in the following subjects:

- Mathematics or ONE science subject (Biology/ Physics/Chemistry/General Science); and
- Any other TWO subjects (including Bahasa Malaysia and/or English)

• Certificate

A Certificate related to Health Sciences with a minimum CGPA 2.50. OR pass SKM (Level 3, MQF) in related field. (Note: The institution may conduct appropriate screening and guidance in line with the field of programme)

English Competency Requirements (International Student)

- Achieve a minimum of Band 3 in MUET; OR equivalent to CEFR (High B1); OR
- IELTS: 5.0; OR
- TOEFL iBT: 40; OR
- Pearson English Test (PTE): 47; OR
- Cambridge English Qualifications and Tests: 154
