Entry Requirements

Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent

- Minimum CGPA of 2.50 in the related field, as accepted by the University Senate; OR
- CGPA below 2.50 in the related field with at least five (5) years of relevant working experience

English Competency Requirements (International Student)

- Achieve a minimum of Band 4 in MUET; OR equivalent to CEFR (Mid B2); OR
- IELTS: 6.0; OR
- TOEFL iBT: 60; OR
- Pearson English Test (PTE): 59; OR
- Cambridge English Qualifications and Tests: 169

Students who do not meet these requirements will be offered an English proficiency course by the University to ensure that their proficiency is sufficient to meet the needs of the programme.

Admission Criteria through APEL.A

- At least 30 years old in the year of application
- Holds a minimum of STPM/Diploma/equivalent qualification (or higher qualifications such as Advanced Diploma, Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma)
- Have at least five (5) years of relevant working experience
- Pass the APEL.A (T7) assessment at the Master's level
